- Clean sneakers in excellent condition (currently unable to accept other types of shoes)
- NO used underwear or socks
- NO Baby/toddler clothes (0-3)
- NO Toys, books, hangers, uniforms, promo/event T's

Donations must be clean/recently washed, folded, and bagged.
